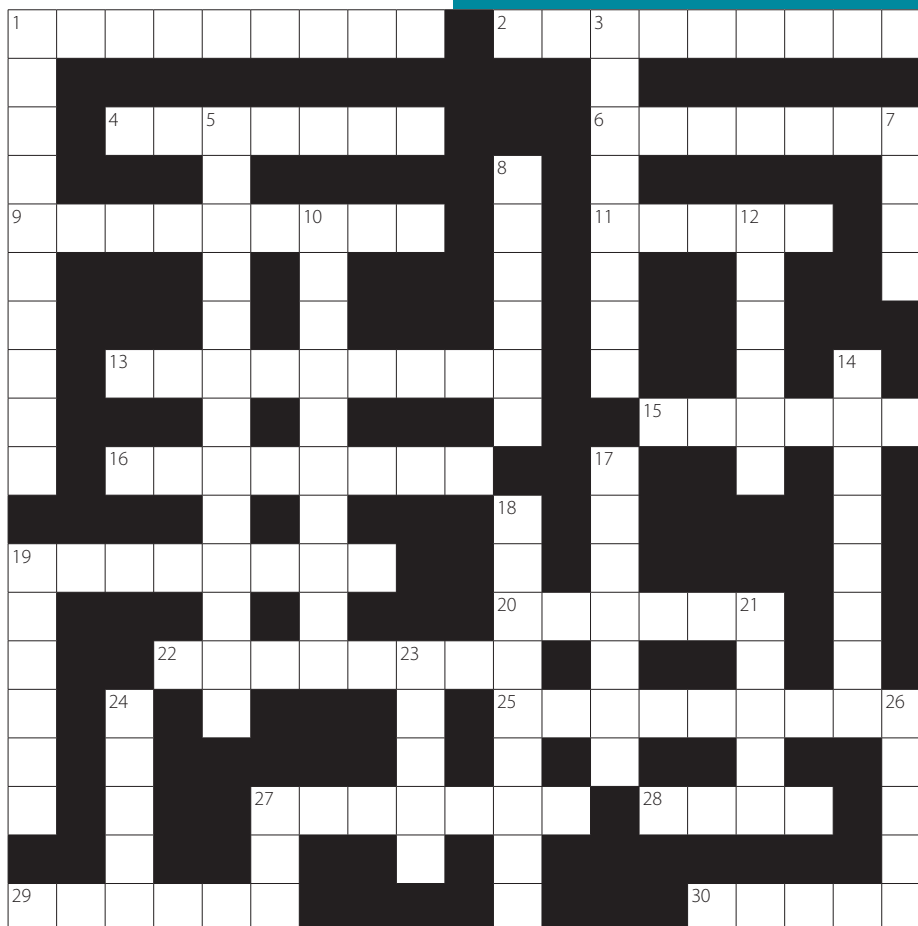


Mould's maze #11
